

19 students of the Technical University of Cluj-Napoca will receive scholarships of 2.400 Euros, in the Roberto Rocca Education Program funded by TenarisSilcotub.

Following an already-established tradition, undergraduates and graduates from the Technical University of Cluj-Napoca enrolled in the competition of the Roberto Rocca Education Program funded by Tenaris Silcotub. Besides the students from the Technical University of Cluj-Napoca, representatives from “Gheorghe Asachi” Technical University of Iasi, Politehnica University from Bucuresti and Petroleum-Gas Ploiesti University. This year the program awarded 40 scholarships. The winners received an annual scholarship of 2.400 Euros that will be paid in equal instalments until September 2014. The winners were selected among hundreds of applicants; their evaluation referred not only to the academic and professional performance, but also to personal and interpersonal skills. The program sets as eligible candidates students in the second or third academic year at Bachelor of Science level or in the first year at Master of Science level in the fields of: mechanical engineering, materials science, electrical engineering, chemical engineering, computer science, industrial automation, manufacturing and economic engineering, petroleum and gas engineering. The scholarships and fellowships can be renewed every academic year, on condition that the candidate satisfies the requirements of professional standards. Candidates are invited to take part in a recruitment session organized by the Human Resources in TenarisSilcotub.

The scholarship winners were conferred the awards, in Zalau, when they also visited OCGT premium production line in which the company invested 62 million Euros.
