Proiectul SALEIE (Strategical Alignment of Electrical and Information Engineering in European Higher Education Institutions), la care Universitatea Tehnică din Cluj-Napoca prin Facultatea de Inginerie Electrică, a fost partenerul nr.17, a ajuns la final.

Scopul proiectului finanțat prin EU Lifelong Learning Programme a fost de a mări numărul de absolvenți calificați de Inginerie Electrică, Energetică și Informatică Aplicată în Europa prin explorarea, analiza și crearea de noi programe de invatamant și politici educationale privind inlaturarea barierelor de acces in invatamantul superior pentru studenții cu dizabilitati și largirea cadrului de schimburi internaționale.

Proiectul a avut trei obiective majore :

- Construirea unei viziuni comune asupra nevoilor ce țin de competențe ale absolvenților pentru a ajuta companiile europene să răspundă la provocările tehnice globale ale momentului;
- Consolidarea înțelegerii la momentul actual a programelor și modulelor academice în ce privește conținutul tehnic și calitatea educatiei ca mijloc de îmbunătățire a competențelor de învățare pentru mobilitate, progres academic și angajare;
- Construirea unei viziuni comune a actualelor practici și probleme legate de promovarea programelor educationale (marketing educational) și sprijinul studenților care provin din medii neconvenționale, precum și al acelora cu nevoi speciale, dizabilitati sau dificultati de invatare.

UTCN a a avut o contributie considerabila in acest proiect prin realizarea versiunii grafice a website-ului dedicat sprijinirii studentilor cu dizabilitati din universitati, a perssonalului din centrele suport a acestora si a personalului didactic implicat in activitati didactice cu acesti studenti.
