The UIC aims to promote the development of high-quality **Open Educational Resources (OER)** for Mathematics, encouraging collaboration and innovation among professionals and enthusiasts in this field.

About the UIC

The UIC is an **open international competition** conducted entirely in **English**, welcoming participation from educators, teachers, professors, undergraduate and graduate students, academic researchers, and anyone interested in creating and improving teaching and learning materials in Mathematics.

To ensure inclusivity, the UIC has been designed to accommodate:

- Individuals with **different abilities and disabilities** (e.g., color blindness, visual impairment).
- Participants facing **economic difficulties** (no participation fees; only internet access is required).
- Individuals with **health restrictions** or from **remote locations** (participation can be carried out remotely).

Key Details

- The competition consists of **two selection stages** (submission and assessment) and a **Final Stage** (open public voting).
- The **submission period for the first stage** starts on **December 2, 2024**.



- **Prizes:** Each stage includes Amazon Gift Cards as rewards for participants.
