

Universal Design for Learning pilot course



Starting from March 1st until May 9th, Dr. Deirdre Mcquillan (TUDublin) will be conducting a pilot course on "Universal Design for Staff Development". The course will be entirely online, taught in English, and offered at no cost.

- + This pilot course for universal design in teaching and learning is modelled on the digital badge developed in partnership with the National Forum for the Enhancement of Teaching and Learning, AHEAD and UCD access & lifelong learning in Ireland.
- + The course will provide educators with a strong introduction to the universal design for learning framework and give them the opportunity to implement UDL approaches within the teaching activities they are currently undertaking.
- + The course is designed for educators but is interesting also for professional and services staff that may also engage with students in their work.
- + The course also aims to train local facilitators that can support greater awareness and emergence of UDL practices in their own institutions; and also support the future development of a European version of the course.
