

Workshop : "How to set up your Blended COIL project"

The Learning Development Network of CUT would like to invite you to the workshop : **"How to set up your Blended COIL project"**.

The workshop is aimed at academics who wish to organize short-term blended mobility projects with one or more European universities. In the new programme generation of the Erasmus+ programme (2021-2027), the opportunities for stays abroad have been greatly expanded and, among other things, supplemented with digital and hybrid elements. The Key Action (KA) 1 - Learning mobility of individuals aims to support physical and mixed mobility of students and university staff. In particular, this action supports Blended Intensive Programmes, which allow groups of higher education institutions to jointly develop blended mobility curricula and activities for students, academic and administrative staff. As part of this action, academic staff and students have the opportunity to actively engage in intercultural communication, interaction and collaboration. At our university, these projects can be informed by the COIL (Collaborative Online International Learning) pedagogical practice and include 1) a period (1 week) of face-to-face on-site study/work at one of our partner institutions in Europe, including EUT+ universities and 2) a period (2-3 weeks) of online project work carried out collaboratively by students at one or more partner universities as part of their coursework, facilitated by the respective professors.
